Regional Source

Langhorne Creek is a premium red wine-grape growing region in South Australia, near Adelaide. It borders on the Bremer River which can overflow in winter, flooding vineyards and contributing to the complexity of the terroir.

Vintage Conditions

A sensational vintage with fruit able to hang in the vineyards that bit longer to get skin and tannin development and wonderful balanced fruit characters.

Vinification

After crushing, vinification was facilitated through yeast inoculation. The wine subsequently spent time exposed to oak to develop depth and character.

Dark solid red in colour.



Nose

The bouquet displays fine fruit with notes of earth.



Palate

This beautifully balanced wine shows a confident openness. The mouthfeel is smooth and shows gravitas and elegance. This is a wine that will delight knowledgeable Shiraz drinkers.
